Impact Weather Briefing for: Thursday, February 19, 2015

■ **Freeze Warning** 1 AM – 9 AM Friday for an *expected* freeze for the following locations:

- Lake Okeechobee Region: Upper 20s-30F
- Rest of interior/West Palm Beach metro (except immediate coast)/Naples metro: 30-32F

■ **Wind Chill Advisory** 11 PM Thursday – 9 AM Friday for All of South Florida

- Wind Chills 25-30F for the Interior and Gulf Coast
- Wind Chills in the lower 30s Atlantic Coast

WATCHES/ADVISORIES:

- *Freeze Warning much of South FL
- *Wind Chill Advisory all of South FL

OVERVIEW:

Cold, dry air will continue to enter South FL today, setting the stage for a cold night... likely the coldest in over 4 years!
