This convenient system mirrors how our Community Center ID works: simply scan your fob to unlock the gate and begin your journey on the water. It's quick, easy, and designed to serve our Surfside community exclusively.

Who Can Get a Key Fob?

- Only Surfside residents are eligible.
- You must be 18 years or older.
- Each fob is linked to your household in the Town of Surfside.

How to Get or Renew Your Kayak Key Fob

Property Owners Bring:

- Government-issued photo ID (e.g., driver's license, passport)
- Proof of residency (utility bill, bank or credit card statement with your Surfside address)

Note: If there are multiple owners, each must provide individual documentation and proof of residency. All applications are subject to approval.

Renters Bring:

- Government-issued photo ID
- A copy of your lease
- Proof of Surfside residency

Fob Expiration & Annual Renewal

Just like your Surfside Community Center ID, your kayak key fob will expire each year at the end of the Town's fiscal year (September 30th). If your household is not active or your account has expired, the key fob will not function. Be sure to renew annually to maintain access.

Lost or Replacement Fobs

• There is a \$5.00 fee for any lost, stolen, or replacement key fob.
