Officer Luke also serves as a member of the Police Honor Guard, is a field training officer and is always willing to take on new assignments when asked. He is dependable, rarely misses work and has an overall upbeat and positive attitude. Luke also made the Chief's high achievers list 12 months in a row during the year 2013.

In addition to the Officer Luke's high productivity he was also nominated for a LEO award in the area of uniform services and received letters of commendation for his participation with the 5th Annual Police Teen Summer Camp Program and Bring Your Child to Work Day. Officer Luke was also commended by Fire Chief Downey of the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue for assisting fire rescue officers with a serious extrication of a child's hand that was stuck in an exercise machine.
