



TOWN OF SURFSIDE MAINTENANCE WORKER II (Parks and Recreation)

DEPARTMENT: PARKS AND RECREATION

NON-EXEMPT

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Semi-skilled manual work in various ground, facilities, and other maintenance activities. Work is performed under direct supervision.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

1. Performs landscape maintenance.
2. May fertilize and treat grounds.
3. Operates Town machinery and equipment as needed.
4. Picks up trash along road sides and other areas.
5. Performs preventative maintenance on various equipment and emergency repairs as needed.
6. Performs heavy manual labor such as: digging, lifting, spraying, etc.
7. Operates cement mixer, sets, forms, pours, shovel and level concrete.
8. May drive vehicles and operate light equipment occasionally.
9. May shovel and spread asphalt.
10. Performs limited electrical work, paints interior and exterior, and maintains signs.
11. Assists in maintaining sprinkler system.
12. Picks up garbage, yard trash, and recyclable materials for disposal.
13. Checks buoys, beach towers, ropes, showers, etc.
14. Works with the public as directed.
15. Performs custodial duties as needed.
16. Performs other duties as assigned.

(These essential job functions are not to be construed as a complete statement of all duties performed. Employees will be required to perform other job-related marginal duties as required.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

- Knowledge of general maintenance tasks and procedures.
- Knowledge of grounds keeping functions and equipment.
- Knowledge of ground maintenance and installation and proper equipment.

- Ability to perform heavy manual labor under adverse weather conditions.
- Ability to follow written and oral instructions.
- Skill in operation and maintenance of equipment and tools related to the position.
- Good customer service skills

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

High school graduation or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. Two (2) years related semi-skilled experience.

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience can be substituted for the minimum qualifications.)

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS:

Valid Florida Driver's License.

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS:

- Moderate to heavy (45 pounds and over) lifting and carrying.
- Walking.
- Standing.
- Stooping.
- Driving.
- Equipment operation.
- Bending and kneeling.
- Climbing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:

- Works out-of-doors in various weather conditions with: dust, dirt, noise.

(Reasonable accommodations will be made for otherwise qualified individuals with a disability.)
