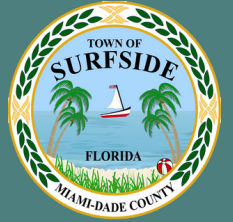


TOWN OF SURFSIDE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT
