

Town of Surfside ID Card Program

New ID Cards and Renewals

1. Duration of ID Cards:

• Property Owners:

ID cards are valid for the fiscal year (Oct 1 - Sep 30). Renewal is required annually at the end of the fiscal year.

Renters:

ID cards must be renewed annually, either at the end of the lease or the fiscal year, whichever comes first.

• For Renewals: Bring your current Surfside ID.

2. How to Obtain or Renew a Surfside ID Card:

Property Owners:

- Documents Needed:
 - Government-issued photo ID (e.g., driver's license, passport)
 - Proof of residency for each owner: utility bill, bank statement, or credit card statement showing Surfside address

Additional Requirements:

• For properties with multiple owners, each owner must provide proof of ownership and proof of residency, subject to supervisory approval.

Renters:

Documents Needed:

- Government-issued photo ID (e.g., driver's license, passport)
- Lease copy showing rental dates and authorized residents
- Proof of residency for each renter: utility bill, bank statement, or credit card statement showing Surfside address

• Short-Term Renters Without a Lease:

- Documents Needed:
 - Notarized Short-Term Renters Temporary Community Center Access Form from the property owner
 - Government-issued photo ID (e.g., driver's license, passport)

3. General Requirements

Proof of Residency:

Everyone 18 years and older must provide proof of residency. All documents must match the Surfside address.

• Family Definition for ID Cards:

ID cards are limited to one family per address (owners or renters). Adult family members and siblings not living at the address are not eligible for ID cards.

• Children's ID Cards:

ID cards are issued to children 1 year and older. Photos may need periodic updates.

Parental Proof is required for children 17 and under.

• Lost or Replacement Cards:

There is a \$5.00 fee for lost, stolen, or replacement cards.

Guest Policy:

- Residents with a current ID card may bring up to five guests per household per day.
 - The cost is \$5.00 per guest.
 - Residents must accompany their guests while in the facility.

Renewal Penalties:

Access to the facility may be denied after three notifications and failure to renew the Resident ID card.
