CRIME PREVENTION/ COMMUNITY INITIATIVES/ LAW ENFORCEMENT EVENTS

The Surfside Police Department is hosting a Women's Self Defense Class for residents on June 4 and June 11 from 5:30pm to 8:00pm at Town Hall. Sgt. Torres will be the instructor. The training shows you how to resist and how to escape a sexual assault. The techniques are easy-to-learn and easy-to-use. The training will show you how to escape a standing assault and what to do if the attacker has you pinned on the ground. These techniques do not require strength, speed or coordination and are perfect for women of all ages and physical types. This class is free of charge. Dina Goldstein will coordinate the classes.

The Surfside Police Department will host training by the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department for Response to high Rise Fires on June 3-6 in the training room from 8:00 am-12:00 pm. The Bal Harbour, Bay Harbor Islands, Sunny Isles Beach, Indian Creek, and Golden Beach Police Departments will also participate.

Lt. Matelis will attend the regional North Miami emergency operations mock hurricane exercise at North Miami PD on June 4 at 9:00 am.

The Surfside Police Department will host a community blood drive on June 5th from 12:30-4:00 pm.

Lt. Williams will attend the quarterly Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Municipal Quarterly Emergency Operations meeting on June 11 at 9:00 am at Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Headquarters.

REGIONAL FIELD FORCE TEAM

The Chiefs of Surfside, Bal Harbour, Bay Harbor Islands, Indian Creek, North Bay Village, Sunny Isles, and Golden Beach will implement an Intracoastal Regional Field Force Team. This Team can be deployed to areas outside of our immediate jurisdictions for civil disturbances. The central purpose of the Team is to be deployed within our jurisdictions for a natural or man-made disaster. Each Chief will assign and equip 5 officers for the Team for a total of 35 officers. A commanding officer and team leaders will be selected from this group of officers by the Chiefs. The Team will be trained in field force and response tactics. Any Sergeant or Officer interested in this position should submit an email to Lt. Matelis by June 13, 2014.

POLICE BICYCLE DETAIL

In addition to daily bicycle patrol in the residential areas, a new bicycle detail will be in effect on Friday evenings.
