HIGH HOLIDAYS DETAIL

P25 RADIO TRANSMISSION PLAN

All handheld radios and vehicles with mobile radios need to be brought to North Miami Police Department (700 N.E. 124 St, North Miami) on Tuesday, October 7, 2014 and Wednesday, October 8, 2014. The radios will receive new firmware and be reprogrammed. This work is scheduled for 1-vehicle per hour from 0600-2200 hrs. The last appointment is 2200 hrs; the vehicle will be completed by 2300 hrs. We have scheduled one spot for every hour. This is mandatory for all personnel and needs to be completed by our Department. Portables radios could be completed 2-per hour at the same time. No overtime is authorized for radio reprograming. Supervisors will be held accountable for their personnel. If you have any questions, please give me a call. The estimated day for MUNI-2 to cutover from EDACS to P25 is Tuesday, October 14, 2014. Notices will be sent out prior to this date confirming the cutover schedule.
