JUNE SIGNIFICANT INVESTIGATIONS/INCIDENTS

Aggravated Battery on Person 65 or Older/DV/Criminal Mischief Arrest

06/04/2017: 1400 block of Biscaya Drive

Officers responded to a call of an elderly female victim who was struck in the face with a phone by her adult son. Upon arrival, officers observed blood and a cut on the victim's nose and a bump on the side of her head. MDPD Fire-Rescue treated the victim on scene. Officers arrested the son and while he was handcuffed in the back of the police vehicle, he raised both of his feet and kicked out the rear driver's side window of the police vehicle.

DWLS W/Knowledge / Fleeing Arrest 06/08/2017: 300 block of 95th Street

While on patrol, the Business District Officer made contact with a driver whose vehicle was standing in a loading zone. Upon attempting to obtain the driver's information, the driver fled from the officer at a high rate of speed demonstrating a wanton disregard for the safety of those around him. A B.O.L.O. for the vehicle was issued and it was located moments later with the driver inside at the Publix lot. The driver told the officers he fled due to his license being suspended. The driver was arrested.

Narcotics (Possession w/ intent to distribute) Arrest

During a traffic stop for an equipment violation, officers smelled a strong odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. A search of the vehicle revealed that a black backpack located on the passenger's side backseat contained 134 grams of marijuana, 32 empty clear plastic bags, 1 grey scale, 2 vape cartridges containing an unknown substance, and 1 grinder containing marijuana residue. The driver was arrested.





Burglary Arrest

Officers responded to a call of an occupied, residential burglary. The victim stated that as she was preparing to sleep she was startled by her ex-boyfriend in her apartment and was unaware that he had a key. She told him multiple times that she did not want any contact with him in person, or by phone or text messaging, but he repeatedly violated her wishes. The subject fled the scene prior to the officers' arrival, but was stopped a short time later as he circled the area. The officers observed, in plain view, an open alcoholic beverage and drug paraphernalia (pipe) with marijuana residue in the subject's vehicle. The subject was arrested.
