## **Narrative:**

The subject disregarded his verbal commands to stop and fled on foot east on 94<sup>th</sup> Street. CSA Sanchez immediately broadcasted over the main police radio channel that a theft had just occurred and gave an excellent description of the subject, what he was wearing and his direction of travel.

Sergeant Jay Matelis heard CSA Sanchez broadcast the information over the radio and quickly arrived in the area. Due to the excellent subject description given by CSA Sanchez, Sergeant Matelis identified the subject and saw him running east in the 200 block of 94<sup>th</sup> Street.
