Rule 7.05 Decorum. Any person making impertinent or slanderous remarks or who becomes boisterous while addressing the commission shall be barred from further appearance before the commission by the presiding officer, unless permission to continue or again address the commission is granted by the majority vote of the commission members present. No clapping, applauding, heckling or verbal outbursts in support or opposition to a speaker or his or her remarks shall be permitted. Signs or placards may be disallowed in the commission chamber by the presiding officer. Persons exiting the commission chambers shall do so quietly.

Rule 6.05 Agenda. The good and welfare portion of the agenda set for 8:15 p.m. shall be restricted to discussion on subjects not already specifically scheduled on the agenda for discussion and debate. In no event shall this portion of the agenda be allotted more than 45 minutes with each speaker to be given no more than three minutes, unless by vote of a majority of the members of the commission present, it is agreed to extend the time frames. Likewise, commission members shall be restricted to speaking three minutes each unless an extension is granted in the same manner as set forth in the prior sentence.

Any person who received compensation, remuneration or expenses for conducting lobbying activities is required to register as a lobbyist with the Town Clerk prior to engaging in lobbying activities per Town Code Sec. 2-235. "Lobbyist" specifically includes the principal, as defined in this section, as well as any agent, officer or employee of a principal, regardless of whether such lobbying activities fall within the normal scope of employment of such agent, officer or employee. The term "lobbyist" specifically excludes any person who only appears as a representative of a not-for-profit community-based organization for the purpose of requesting a grant without special compensation or reimbursement for the appearance; and any person who only appears as a representative of a neighborhood, homeowners or condominium association without compensation for the appearance, whether direct or indirect or contingent, to express support of or opposition to any item.

Per Miami Dade County Fire Marshal, the Commission Chambers has a maximum capacity of 99 people. Once reached this capacity, people will be asked to watch the meeting from the first floor.

Subject: Repealing of Ordinance No. 2019-1698 (Amending Section 34-11 of the Town Code to Prohibit the Distribution, Sale or Use of Single-Use Plastics, including Singe Use Plastic Bags).

At the August 13, 2019 Town Commission meeting, for recent legal challenges and applicable state legislation, the Town Commission directed staff to prepare a Notice of Intent to Repeal Ordinance No. 2019-1698 (Amending Section 34-11 of the Town Code to prohibit the distribution, sale or use of single-use plastics, including single-use plastic bags). The Notice of Intent to Repeal was published on August 16, 2019, as required by Section 57.112, Florida Statutes, and the attached Ordinance will be heard on first reading on this date with second reading to occur on September 10, 2019.

Repeal of Ordinance No. 2019-1698 in its entirety will result in the reinstatement of Section 34-11 of the Code as existed prior to adoption of Ordinance No. 2019-1698.

<u>Commission direction</u>: Town Staff recommends approval on first reading of the proposed ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE 2 FLORIDA. 3 TOWN OF SURFSIDE. REPEALING **ORDINANCE** NO. 2019-1698, WHICH AMENDED 4 5 PORTIONS OF SECTION 34-11, "PROHIBITION ON DISTRIBUTION, SALE OR USE OF PLASTIC STRAWS" 6 7 OF THE TOWN'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND 8 AMENDED THE TITLE TO **"PROHIBITION** ON **DISTRIBUTION**, SALE 9 OR USE OF SINGLE-USE PLASTICS," PROVIDED FOR 10 DEFINITIONS FOR SINGLE-USE PLASTICS, AND REGULATING SINGLE-11 **USE PLASTICS: PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION:** 12 **PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR** 13 CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE 14 DATE. 15

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WHEREAS, on July 9, 2019, the Town of Surfside (the "Town") Commission adopted
 Ordinance No. 2019-1698 amending Section 34-11 of the Town Code of Ordinances ("Code") to
 provide a prohibition on the distribution, sale, or use of single-use plastics, including single-use
 plastic bags; and

WHEREAS, given recent legal challenges and applicable state legislation, the Town
 Commission desires to repeal Ordinance No. 2019-1698 and reinstate the provisions of Section
 34-11 of the Town Code as existed prior to the adoption of Ordinance No. 2019-1698; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds that this Ordinance is in the best interests ofthe Town.

# NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE HEREBY ORDAINS:<sup>1</sup>

27 <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The above-stated recitals are true and correct and are
 28 incorporated herein by this reference.

29 <u>Section 2.</u> <u>Repeal.</u> That Ordinance No. 2019-1698 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
30 Section 34-11 of the Town Code shall be reinstated as it existed prior to the adoption of
31 Ordinance No. 2019-1698.

32 <u>Section 3.</u> <u>Codification.</u> It is the intent of the Town Commission that the provisions 33 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Town's Code of Ordinances, and that 34 the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered, and the word "ordinance" may 35 be changed to "section," "article," "regulation," or such other appropriate word or phrase in 36 order to accomplish such intentions.

37 <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be 38 severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be 39 held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining 40 sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it 41 being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any 42 part.

43 <u>Section 5.</u> <u>Conflicts.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolutions or parts of 44 resolutions, in conflict herewith, are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

45 <u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon
 46 final adoption on second reading.
