A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF TOWN OF SURFSIDE, THE **MIAMI-DADE** COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF A MILLAGE RATE AGAINST ALL TAXABLE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014/2015; AND REAFFIRMING SEPTEMBER 2014 AS 23, THE DATE ADOPTION OF THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of Surfside, Florida of Miami-Dade County finds it necessary to levy an ad valorem millage rate in the Town of Surfside, and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2014 at 6:30 p.m., the Town Commission held a Public Hearing regarding such ad valorem millage rate as required by Florida Statute 200.65.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above and foregoing recitals are true and correct.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Adoption of Tentative Millage.</u> The millage rate of 5.2000 mills is hereby adopted as the tentative millage rate for the Town of Surfside.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Comparative.</u> The tentative millage rate of 5.2000 mills is more than the rolled-back rate of 4.3990 mills as established by the State of Florida Truth in Millage (TRIM) of 18.21%.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Finalization of Millage.</u> A final public hearing shall be held on September 23, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. to adopt the final millage rate.
