

RESOLUTION NO. 16 - 2382

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER AND/OR DESIGNEE TO EXPEND FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,000.00 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2015/2016 MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT ACCOUNT NO. 401-9900-536-6410 PURCHASE A HOMA AMX644-350/60GU/CFM DRY PIT NON-CLOG SEWAGE PUMP FROM BARNEY'S PUMPS, INC.; WAIVING THE BID PROCESS PURSUANT TO SECTION 3-13(6) OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on July 12, 2011, the Town Commission adopted Resolution No. 11-2028 approving the award of a competitive bid to Ric-Man International, Inc. for the Infrastructure Rehabilitation Project;

**WHEREAS**, as part of the larger Infrastructure Rehabilitation Project, all four (4) of the Town's sanitary sewage pumps, were replaced with HOMA AMX644-350/60GU/CFM dry pit non-clog sewage pumps from Barney's Pumps, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, at the Town's two stations, two pumps per station operate 24 hours per day, 7 days per week and 365 days per year to transmit the sewage out of the Town via a shared force main pressurized line south into Miami Beach; and

**WHEREAS**, as with any moving mechanical part, minor regular maintenance coupled with long term intensive overhauls is required to keep the pumps consistently operational; and

**WHEREAS**, it is industry standard, as well as the manufacturer's recommendation to service each of the Town's four (4) sanitary sewer pumps at regular intervals; and

**WHEREAS**, larger overhaul maintenance requires that a pump be removed and shipped to the manufacturer; and

**WHEREAS**, depending on the type of service required, the Town would operate with one (1) less sanitary sewer pump at a given site for up to 2-3 weeks; and

**WHEREAS**, operating with only one (1) pump and without a backup is not recommended and is not industry standard; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town does not have a standby replacement pump; and

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of an additional pump would allow for a pump swap out during the time of long term maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, the pump was approved as a part of the 2015/2016 Fiscal Year budget with a budget impact of \$35,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 3-12 of the Town Code, after conducting a good faith review of available sources, due to the nature of the goods and in receipt of a written request by the department head (See Attachment 'A') pursuant to Section 3-13(6) of the Town Code, the Town Manager has recommended that it is in the Town's best interest to waive the Town's competitive bidding procedures as a sole source exemption; and

**WHEREAS**, is in the best interest of the Town to authorize the expenditure of funds in the amount not to exceed \$35,000.00 to purchase a HOMA AMX644-350/60GU/CFM dry pit non-clog sewage pump from Barney's Pumps, Inc., (Attachment "B") as the sole supplier for the replacement pumps.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

**Section 2. Authorization to Expend Funds.** The Town Manager and/or designee are authorized to expend funds in an amount of \$35,000.00 from the Machinery and Equipment Account No. 401-9900-536-6410 to purchase a HOMA AMX644-350/60GU/CFM dry pit non-clog sewage pump.

**Section 3. Implementation.** The Town Manager is hereby authorized to take any and all action necessary to implement this Resolution.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
