

RESOLUTION NO. 16 – 2396

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVYING OF A MILLAGE RATE AGAINST ALL TAXABLE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2016/2017; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Town Commission of Surfside, Florida finds it necessary to levy an ad valorem millage rate in the Town of Surfside; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2016, the Town Commission adopted a tentative millage rate of 5.0293 after the initial public hearing regarding such ad valorem millage rate as required by §200.065, Fla.Stat. (2016); and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2016, the Town Commission held the second and final public hearing regarding such ad valorem millage rate as required by §200.065, Fla.Stat. (2016); and

WHEREAS, the public hearings on September 13, 2016 and September 27, 2016 on the millage were scheduled at the Town of Surfside, Florida, Surfside Municipal Building, Town Hall Commission Chambers, 9293 Harding Ave, Surfside, Florida at 5:01 pm; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Town Commission to adopt a final millage rate of 5.0144, which is more than the rolled back rate of 4.4285 mills as established by the State of Florida Truth in Millage (TRIM) of 13.23%.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above and foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. Adoption of Final Millage. That, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017, the millage rate of 5.0144 mills is hereby adopted as the final millage rate for the Town of Surfside which is \$5.01 dollars per \$1,000 of assessed property within the Town of Surfside.

Section 3. Rolled-Back Rate. That the current year rolled-back rate, computed pursuant to §200.065, Fla.Stat. (2016), is 4.4285 mills.

Section 4. Comparative. The final millage rate of 5.0144 mills is more than the rolled-back rate of 4.4285 mills as established by the State of Florida Truth in Millage (TRIM) of 13.23%.

Section 5. Authorization and Implementation. That the Town Manager and Town Clerk

are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all such actions as are required to implement this levy for the fiscal year October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

Section 6. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




