

RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 2443

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018; ANNOUNCING THE PERCENTAGE INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAXES; CONFIRMING DATE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser (“Property Appraiser”) has certified the taxable value within the Town of Surfside (the “Town”) for the year 2017 which includes all real property within the Town; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2017, the Town Commission adopted Resolution No. 2017-2438 determining the proposed millage rate for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2017 and further scheduled public hearings on the millage rate as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the first hearing to be held on Tuesday, September 12, 2017 at 5:01 P.M. and the second to be held on Tuesday, September 26, 2017 at 5:01 P.M., both at Town of Surfside Town Hall, Commission Chambers, 9293 Harding Avenue, Surfside, Florida 33154; and

WHEREAS, the first scheduled budget hearing was cancelled in the aftermath of Hurricane Irma and rescheduled to September 18, 2017, pursuant to the Governor’s Executive Order 17-235 issued on September 4, 2017 and the Department of Revenue Emergency Order Implementing Provisions of Executive Order Number 17-235 (RE: Hurricane Irma) issued September 6, 2017 and amended on September 8, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Department of Revenue Amended Emergency Order Implementing Provisions of Executive Order Number 17-235 (RE: Hurricane Irma) issued on September 8, 2017, notice of the rescheduled hearing was provided in The Miami Herald on September 16, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission and the Town Manager have reviewed the Town’s proposed Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget, considered an estimate of the necessary expenditures contemplated for in the Budget, and have determined that the proposed millage rate levy set forth below provides the necessary funds for such expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That the above-stated recitals are hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Adopting Proposed Millage Rate. The millage rate of 4.8000 mills is hereby adopted as the proposed millage rate for the Town of Surfside.

Section 3. Announcing Percentage Increase. The proposed millage rate of 4.8000 mills exceeds the rolled-back rate computed pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes of 4.6913 mills by 2.32%, which is the percentage increase in property taxes tentatively adopted by the Town.

Section 4. Confirming Date of Second Public Hearing. The Town confirms that it will hold a public hearing to finally adopt the millage rate and budget for fiscal year 2017-2018 on Tuesday, September 26, 2017 at 5:01 P.M. at Town of Surfside Town Hall, Commission Chambers, 9293 Harding Avenue, Surfside, Florida 33154.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


