A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE SURFSIDE. TOWN OF FLORIDA. **AMENDING** RESOLUTION NO. 2023-2962 TO APPROVE AND **AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF FIVE (5) 2023 FORD** INTERCEPTOR UTILITY VEHICLES; FINDING THAT THE PURCHASE OF THE POLICE VEHICLESIS IS EXEMPT FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING PURSUANT TO SECTION 3-13(3) OF THE TOWN CODE: PROVIDING FOR **IMPLEMENTATION:** AND **PROVIDING** FOR AN **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2023, the Town Commission of the Town of Surfside ("Town") adopted Resolution No. 2023-2962, approving and authorizing the purchase of nine (9) Ford Police Vehicles together with emergency lighting equipment, graphics, radio equipment, and radio programming for each police vehicle (the "January Purchase"); and

WHEREAS, the January Purchase included the purchase of five (5) 2023 Ford Interceptor Utility AWD vehicles ("Police Vehicles") from a Florida dealer, Garber Ford, utilizing the Florida Association of Sheriffs' Association Number FSAA22-VEL30.0 ("FSA Contract"), and allocated \$244,126.00 for the purchase of the Police Vehicles as detailed in the Purchase Order attached hereto as Attachment "A"; and

WHEREAS, due to a nationwide vehicle shortage and the current closure of Ford factories due to a union strike, the Police Vehicles are not available for purchase from a Florida dealer; and

WHEREAS, the Town has been able to locate the Police Vehicles from a State of Georgia dealership, Legacy Ford, who has provided a quote and specifications sheets for the Police Vehicles attached hereto as Attachment "B", consistent with the pricing previously obtained by the Town through the FSA Contract, for a total price of \$236,950.00, which represents a savings of \$7,176.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission desires to amend Resolution No. 2023-2962 to modify the January Purchase to approve and authorize the purchase of the Police Vehicles pursuant to the Quote attached hereto as Attachment "B"; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds that the purchase contemplated by the Town for the Police Vehicles has already been competitively bid in the FSA Contract and is exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to Section 3-13(3) of the Town's Code of Ordinances ("Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission desires to authorize the Town Manager to purchase the Police Vehicles from Legacy Ford at a revised cost of \$236,950.00, based on the pricing of the FSA Contract pursuant to Section 3-13(3) of the Town's Code and consistent with the quote attached hereto as Attachment "B" ("New Vehicle Purchase"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above-stated recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Amending Resolution No. 2022-2962.</u> Resolution No. 2022-2962 is hereby amended to provide for the Town Commission approval and authorization of the New Vehicle Purchase from Legacy Ford in the amount of \$236,950.00, in accordance with the quote attached hereto as Attachment "B".

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Exemption from Competitive Bidding.</u> The Town Commission hereby finds that the New Vehicle Purchase utilizing the FSA Contract is exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to Section 3-13(3) of the Town Code.

Section 4. Implementation. That the Town Commission hereby authorizes the Town Manager to execute any purchase order or required documentation for the New Vehicle Purchase described in this Resolution, subject to approval by the Town Attorney as to form and legality, and to take any action which is reasonably necessary to implement the purpose of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

Versions must not charge for any of these tees. The Town cases the right to cancel this P.O. at any time, should the Vendor not comply with any of the Terms and Conditions havelin.

- 1. Acceptance of Contract: This purchase order ("P.O.") is the Town's offer to purchase the goods and/or services from Vendor pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth harein. Upon acceptance of this P.O., by delivery of goods or performance of the services, this P.O. shall become a contract and subsequently binding upon Vendor, Any separately executed contract between the Town and a Vendor supersedes the terms and conditions of this P.O.

All specifications, drawings, data or any other related documentation submitted to the Vendor with the P.O. are hereby incorporated and made a part hereof.

Indemnity: Vendor shall defend, indernrify and held harmless the Town, it's officers, agents, employees and successors, framend against any and all claims, itabilities, demages, demands, losses, causes of action and auts, including research sticropy? Sees incident thereto, to the extent they result directly from or out of any injury to or death of any person or demage to or destruction of any property caused by the negligent acts, errors, ordestors or within misconduct of Vendor. 
