## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-3325**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE. **APPROVING** FLORIDA. ADDITIONAL CONSTRUCTION PHASE DESIGN AND ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES FROM SAVINO & MILLER DESIGN STUDIO. P.A. **PURSUANT** TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR THE 96 **PARK** STREET PROJECT: **AUTHORIZING** THE **FUNDS**; EXPENDITURE OF **PROVIDING** FOR IMPLEMENTATION: AND **PROVIDING** FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the Town of Surfside ("Town") issued Request for Qualifications No. 2020-02 (the "RFQ") requesting qualifications from firms experienced and qualified to provide design and architectural services (the "Services") for the 96 Street Park Project (the "Project'); and

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2021, the Town Commission adopted Resolution No. 2021-2815, approving an agreement with Savino & Miller Design Studio, P.A., including William Lane Architecture (the "Consultant"), to provide the Services for the Project pursuant to the RFQ, and the parties entered into a Professional Services Agreement dated February 12, 2021, for the Project (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2022, the Town Commission adopted Resolution No. 2022-2951, selecting and awarding a contract for construction for the Project to Lunacon Engineering Group, Corp. ("Lunacon"); and

WHEREAS, the Town requires additional Services from the Consultant for the construction phase of the Project due to additional coordination and meetings with Lunacon, the Town and Codegreen, additional sites documentation, additional construction management and architecture for the Project (the "Additional Services"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement, the Consultant has agreed to provide the Additional Services, with a scope of services and fees in an amount not to exceed \$45,000, as set forth in the Consultant's Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A,"; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission wishes to approve the Additional Services, consistent with the terms and conditions of the Agreement and the Consultant's Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and authorize the expenditure of funds in an amount not to exceed \$45,000; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Commission finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the Town and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> Each of the above-stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Approval of Additional Services and Contractor's Proposal. The Additional Services are hereby approved, consistent with the terms and conditions of the Agreement and the Consultant's Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 3. Authorization; Expenditure of Funds. The Town Manager is hereby authorized to expend funds for the Additional Services in an amount not to exceed \$45,000, consistent with the terms and conditions of the Agreement and the Consultant's Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The Town Manager and Town Officials are authorized to take all necessary action to implement the Additional Services and the purposes of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Dear Mr. Eugent,

The Design / Architectural Services team for Surfside 96<sup>th</sup> St Park is requesting Additional Professional Service Fees for the ongoing Construction Phase of the Project due to an extended schedule, unforeseen construction complications and ongoing site visits to approve and correct work completed by the General Contractor.

As Prime Consultant and Landscape Architect, Savino Miller Design Studio is requesting additional professional service fees to continue our involvement in the Construction and Closeout Phase of the project through October 2024, an additional five months beyond the scope of our previous additional fee request and nine months beyond the contracted substantial completion date.

We are also requesting additional fees to finish the LEED and Sites Commissioning and Certification process, which extends several months beyond the end of project construction. Tasks involved include regular meetings with the LEED/Sites consultant [Codegreen, formerly Sequil], creating SITES documentation for submittal, responding to reviewer comments, onsite soil testing, documenting built conditions and coordination meetings with the Town and Town's maintenance contractor, Brightview.

Our subconsultant, William Lane Architecture, is also requesting additional fees due to the extending construction schedule. See attached letter for additional details.
