

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 3525**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT OF ATTORNEYS' FEES RELATING TO GOLDSTEIN V. TOWN OF SURFSIDE, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF FLORIDA CASE NO. 1:25-CV-24805-KMM; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 10, 2026, the Town Commission for the Town of Surfside approved a Limited Settlement Agreement and Release of FLSA Claims in connection with the Case styled *Goldstein v. Town of Surfside*, United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, Case No. L:25-Cv-24805, pertaining to alleged violations of the Fair Labor Standards Act (the "FLSA Litigation"); and

**WHEREAS**, an Executive Session of the Town Commission was held on May 5, 2026 on the settlement of attorneys' fees in connection with the FLSA Litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties have agreed to an amount for attorneys' fees to Plaintiff Goldstein's counsel in the amount of \$28,000 for legal fees incurred in the FLSA Litigation, and that a final stipulation of dismissal be filed in the FLSA Litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Commission wishes to approve and authorize the payment of attorneys' fees to Plaintiff's counsel in the amount of \$28,000, and the filing of a final stipulation of dismissal in the FLSA Litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Commission finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** Each of the above-stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

**Section 2. Approval.** The Town Commission approves the payment of attorneys' fees to Plaintiff Goldstein's counsel in the amount of \$28,000 and the filing of a final stipulation of dismissal in the FLSA Litigation.

**Section 3. Authorization.** The Town Commission authorizes the Town Manager, Town Attorney and Special Legal Counsel for the FLSA Litigation to take any and all action necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.




