

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-3557

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2026-3518 AND RESOLUTION NO. 2026-3519, AND WITHDRAWING THE RESOLUTIONS PROVIDING FOR CHARTER AMENDMENTS FROM THE BALLOT ON THE NOVEMBER 3, 2026 SPECIAL ELECTION; CANCELLING THE TOWN'S NOVEMBER 3, 2026 SPECIAL ELECTION CALLED FOR IN THE RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR NOTIFICATION AND TRANSMITTAL TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2026, the Town Commission of the Town of Surfside ("Town") adopted Resolution No. 2026-3518, calling for a Town special election to be held on November 3, 2026 for the purpose of submitting to the electorate an amendment to the Town's Charter, Amending Article II, "Town Commission", Section 11, "Powers of Commission", Subsection (16) to require a majority vote in lieu of unanimous vote of the Town Commission for expenditures over \$2,000,000, and providing for requisite ballot language and charter amendment text for submission to the electorate ("Resolution No. 2026-3518"); and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2026, the Town Commission of the Town of Surfside ("Town") adopted Resolution No. 2026-3519, calling for a Town special election to be held on November 3, 2026 for the purpose of submitting to the electorate an amendment to the Town's Charter, Amending Article II, "Town Commission", Section 11, "Powers of Commission", Subsection (17) to remove the requirement that a 60% vote of the electors is needed to expend more than 20% of the most recent budgeted property tax revenue

collections, and providing for requisite ballot language and charter amendment text for submission to the electorate ("Resolution No. 2026-3519"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission desires to rescind Resolution No. 2026-3518 and Resolution No. 2026-3519 (collectively, the "Resolutions"), and to withdraw the Resolutions providing for the Charter amendments from the ballot on the November 3, 2026 special election, and cancel the Town's special election called for in the foregoing Resolutions to be held on November 3, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission hereby directs that notice of the rescission of the Resolutions, and the withdrawal of the Resolutions providing for the Charter amendments, and cancellation of the November 3, 2026 special election be provided to the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections, and further authorizes the Acting Town Manager, Town Clerk and Town Attorney to take all action necessary to accomplish the withdrawal of the Resolutions and cancellation of the special election on November 3, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds that this Resolution is in the best interests of the Town and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. Each of the above stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Resolution Nos. 2026-3518 and 2026-3519 Calling for Special Election and Charter Amendments Rescinded and Withdrawn; Special Election Cancelled. The Town Commission hereby rescinds the Resolutions, withdraws the

Resolutions providing for the Charter amendments from the ballot on the November 3, 2026 special election, and cancels the Town's special election called for in the Resolutions to be held on November 3, 2026.

Section 3. Notice and Transmittal to Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections. Town Commission hereby directs that notice of the rescission and withdrawal of the Resolutions, and cancellation of the November 3, 2026 special election be provided to the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections and all other parties as required by law.

Section 4. Authorization; Implementation. The Acting Town Manager, Town Clerk, and Town Attorney are authorized to take any and all necessary or further action to swiftly implement the purposes of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

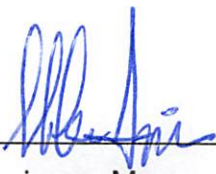

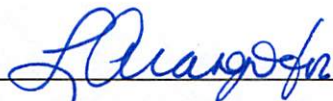
