## 1 **ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 1795** 2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF 3 THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA REPLACING 4 SECTION 2-26 OF CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2 5 "RESERVED" WITH SECTION 6 "COMMISSIONERS' USAGE OF OFFICES IN TOWN 7 HALL": PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION AND 8 INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR 9 SEVERABILITY: PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS: 10 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 11 12 WHEREAS, Article II, Section 7 of the Town of Surfside Charter provides that "the 13 mayor and members of commission shall be paid the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) per fiscal 14 year for attendance at monthly council meetings, irrespective of the number of regular or 15 special meetings attended within such fiscal year", implying a prohibition on additional 16 perks and remuneration to the mayor and members of the Town Commission; and 17 WHEREAS, the Town Commission seeks to explicitly prohibit the Mayor, Vice-Mayor 18 and any Commissioner from permanently occupying any designated office in Town Hall 19 during their Term; and 20 WHEREAS, the Town Commission intends that such prohibitions be enforced 21 regardless of approval of such actions by the majority of the Commission; and 22 WHEREAS, the adoption of the provisions set forth below are necessary to 23 accomplish the above objectives; and 24 WHEREAS, the Town Commission held its first public hearing on Sept. 9, 2025, and 25 approved the proposed amendment to the Code of Ordinances having complied with the 26 notice requirements in Florida Statutes; and WHEREAS, the Town Commission held its second public hearing on \_\_\_\_\_\_, 27 2025, and approved the proposed amendment to the Code of Ordinances having 28 29 complied with the notice requirements in Florida Statutes; and 30 WHEREAS, the Town Commission hereby finds that this Ordinance is in the best 31 interest and welfare of the residents and visitors of the Town. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE 32 **TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA:** 33 34

- 35 <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The above Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference:
- 37 <u>Section 2.</u> Town Code Amended. Chapter 2, Article II, Sec. 2-26 ("Reserved")
- is hereby replaced with the following:
- 39 Sec. 2-26. Reserved. Commissioners' Usage of Offices in Town Hall.
- 40 The Town's commission-manager form of government depends on a separation of the
- legislative and administrative functions, with the latter reserved for the Town Manager.
- 42 The regular, physical presence of elected officials in Town Hall, as well as their
- 43 <u>interactions with Town staff, can threaten that separation.</u>
- 44 Notwithstanding the preceding, commissioners may have some legitimate need related
- 45 to their official position to use space in Town Hall. The purpose of this Ordinance is to
- 46 attempt to accommodate a commissioner's legitimate need to temporarily use space in
- 47 Town Hall without infringing on the Town Manager's ability to perform his administrative
- 48 functions without interference by commissioners with Town staff.
- 49 The Town Manager shall designate a space within Town Hall that commissioners can
- 50 use, on occasion, for discrete, Town-related purposes such as meetings with
- 51 constituents. The Town Manager shall ensure that all commissioners have equal access
- to that space, and that its use is limited to discrete, Town-related purposes. Prior to such
- 53 use, and so that the Town Manager can make the necessary arrangements.
- 54 Commissioners must notify the Town Manager in writing of any meetings to be held in
- 55 Town Hall with non-Town personnel identifying the attendees, purpose, and anticipated
- 56 duration of such meetings.
- 57 The Mayor, Vice-Mayor and commissioners are each prohibited from permanently
- occupying any office in Town Hall and from keeping their personal effects in any Town
- office. "Permanently" shall be defined as using any office or offices for a total amount of
- 60 time exceeding three hours in any 5 calendar day period. The time limitation shall not
- 61 apply to meetings with the Town Manager or Town Attorney.
- The act of any commissioner in violating the provisions of this section shall constitute an
- 63 act of misfeasance in office.
- 64 Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this
- Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction,
- then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
- 67 Ordinance.

**Inclusion in the Code**. It is the intention of the Town Commission, 68 and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and made a 69 part of the Town of Surfside Code of Ordinances, that the sections of this Ordinance may 70 be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intentions; and the word "Ordinance" may 71 be changed to "Section" or other appropriate word. 72 Conflicts. Any and all ordinances and resolutions or parts of Section 5. 73 ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. 74 Section 6. Effective Date.
