## Summary of Noteworthy Calls for Service

Officers responded to a call regarding two males possibly drowning. Upon arrival, lifeguards were already in the ocean actively engaged in a rescue. It was determined that a juvenile male had suffered a leg cramp and became caught in a strong rip current. A second male, a friend, entered the water to assist him. Lifeguards successfully rescued the juvenile and brought him safely to shore. He was alert, coherent, and in good spirits. Miami-Dade Fire Rescue (MDFR) responded, treated the juvenile on scene, and released him to his father, who had arrived shortly after. Report completed.

04/25/2025 The ft Attempt CVS Pharmacy

While conducting a Business District Check, the officer was informed of an incident involving a female who attempted to steal several items from CVS. When approached by the store manager, the female placed the items on the ground and fled the scene.

04/27/2025 Arrest 8900 Block of Harding Avenue

A records check revealed an active warrant out of Broward County. The subject was taken into custody and transported to TGK by SPD and Warrants personnel.
