Summary of Noteworthy Calls for Service

05/19/2025 Stolen Vehicle Recovery 9048 Bay Drive

On May 18, 2025, at approximately 7:00 PM, officers responded to a report of a stolen vehicle. The victim reported that his 2025 Range Rover had been taken from his residence. The vehicle had been left unlocked with the keys inside. The theft was discovered by the owner the following morning on May 19, 2025, at approximately 7:00 AM, at which time police were contacted. The Criminal Investigations Unit was notified and took over the investigation. Through investigative efforts, detectives were able to locate the stolen vehicle on May 20, 2025. The vehicle's recovery is currently under further investigation to identify and apprehend the suspects involved.

05/21/2025 Theft 9400 Harding Ave

On May 27, 2025, store management contacted law enforcement to report a theft that had just occurred. According to management, a male subject entered the store and took a package of meat valued at \$23.00 without rendering payment. Responding officers conducted an area canvass but were unable to locate the subject at that time. A review of the store's CCTV footage identified the individual as the same male involved in a lewd and lascivious incident at the store on May 16, 2025. The Criminal Investigations Unit was notified and briefed on the incident. A report was completed and forwarded to CIU for further investigation.

05/21/2025 Assist other Agency/Burglary 11601 Biscayne Blvd

While on the way to a car wash, an officer and his trainee were flagged down by a citizen reporting a burglary in progress. The complainant stated that a male subject was inside an office building attempting to force entry into multiple offices. Responding officers quickly located the subject and detained him without incident. The Miami Dade Sheriff Office responded to the scene and assumed control of the investigation.

05/21/2025 Theft 9400 Harding Ave

An officer responded to a report of stolen merchandise. Upon arrival, the complainant provided a photograph of the suspect, described as a white male with short black hair, last seen wearing a black short-sleeve shirt and black shorts. The officer conducted an area check, but the subject had already fled the scene and was not located. The case was forwarded to the Criminal Investigations Unit for follow-up investigation.

05/22/2025	Deceased Person	9559 Collins Ave

Units responded in reference to a deceased person. Upon arrival, officers discovered a 75-year-old female lying on the bathroom floor of her residence. Miami-Dade Fire Rescue responded and pronounced the female deceased at the scene. Miami-Dade Homicide and Miami-Dade Crime Scene Investigators were notified and responded to conduct a thorough investigation. After completing their assessment, no foul play was suspected, and the body was released to the family for funeral arrangements.

05/25/2025 Theft 9349 Abbott Ave

Officers responded in reference to a theft that occurred in front of a residence. The complainant reported that a scooter was stolen from the front of the home. Officers completed a report and this case was referred to the Criminal Investigations Unit for further follow-up.
