Summary of Noteworthy Calls for Service

05/27/2025	Theft	9516 Harding Ave
Officers responded to a report of a stolen scooter. The victim stated that he had parked the scooter at the listed location, and upon returning, discovered it was no longer there. Officers reviewed surveillance footage from the area and observed an unidentified male individual taking the scooter. A report was completed and forwarded to CIU for further investigation.		

05/28/2025	Attempted Theft	9532 Carlyle Ave
Officers responded to a report of a male subject who attempted to take an electric scooter. Video surveillance footage shows the individual trying to leave the scene with the scooter, however, due to a flat tire, the suspect abandoned it in front of the property. A police report was completed, and the case has been forwarded to CIU for further investigation.		

05/29/2025	Theft	9500 Block of Collins Ave
While on patrol, an officer was flagged down by a couple at the beach in reference to a theft. The couple reported that a purse had been stolen while they were at the location. The officer gathered the necessary information, documented the incident, and forwarded the case to CIU for follow up.		

05/28/2025	Assault	9454 Harding Ave
The victim reported that an intoxicated male entered the restaurant and became confrontational with him after asking if he needed assistance. The victim said that the male removed his shirt and said "I'll kill you" before grabbing his cellular phone and exiting the restaurant. The victim reported that he followed the male outside as he tried to flee southbound on Harding Avenue on a bicycle. After a short distance, the male dropped the victims cell phone on the sidewalk. As the victim tried to grab his phone, the male grabbed a metal chair and began chasing the victim, attempting to strike him with the chair. The male subsequently threw the chair at the victim and fled south on Harding Avenue. The subject was later identified by our investigators and an arrest was made on June 2 nd , 2025.		

05/29/2025	Information	9538 Harding Ave
Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at a Subway restaurant. Upon arrival, the employee stated that an unknown homeless male had entered the store and became involved in a verbal dispute with the employee over allegedly burnt food. As the individual was leaving, a customer reported that the subject stated he would "go get a gun." A BOLO was broadcast over the municipal radio, and units conducted an area search for the individual. At this time the subject has not been located.
