

In addition to pelicans and seabirds, we treat more than a hundred species each year, including native mammals like the Virginia Opossum and reptiles like the threatened Gopher Tortoise. Thanks to community and foundation support, in 2024, we treated 2,476 patients, representing 145 species!

The most commonly treated species at the Seabird Station in 2024 were the Brown Pelican, Laughing Gull, Virginia Opossum, Grey Squirrel, Northern Mockingbird, Blue Jay, and Eastern Screech Owl. Your donation helps support the care and treatment of these birds and many more. We are deeply grateful to **YOU** for your support, and thank you for being a champion of injured native wildlife and efforts towards conservation education.

Philanthropic efforts by foundations account for 44% of our annual operating budget. This generous funding will help us continue to provide professional care to over 2,000 patients of more than 100 native birds and wildlife species.
