NOTICE OF SIDEWALK SANDBLASTING PROJECT - DOWNTOWN DISTRICT

The Town of Surfside will be sandblasting the sidewalks and curbs within its Downtown Business District as part of scheduled maintenance and beautification efforts.

Work Schedule:

- **Start Date:** Sunday, August 24, 2025
- **Hours:** Nightly from 9:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.
- **Estimated Completion:** September 19, 2025

Location Details:

- From **August 24th through August 29th**, work will take place on the **west side of Harding Avenue**, between **96th Street and 95th Street**.
- From **August 31st through September 5th**, work will take place on the **west side of Harding Avenue**, between **95th Street and 94th Street**.
- From **September 7th through September 12th**, work will take place on the **east side of Harding Avenue**, between **96th Street and 95th Street**.
- From **September 14th through September 19th**, work will take place on the **east side of Harding Avenue**, between **95th Street and 94th Street**.

During these dates and times, no sidewalk tables/seating is authorized, and street parking is prohibited. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to improve and beautify our community.
