Any Capital Improvement Project will require a substantial investment of funds by the Town. Therefore, it is recommended that projects of substantial investment are funded in such a way that funds can be replenished over a period of time. Fully funding a project solely from reserves comes at an opportunity cost and may limit the Town's ability to fund other projects later. Abbott Avenue Stormwater Improvement Projects was budgeted for fiscal year 2023 and fiscal year 2024 at \$3,850,000 with grant funding included.
