Below is a weekly overview of key administration activities per department for the week of January 02, 2023:

Parks and Recreation Department

- Mid-year Main pool slide inspection passed. It was conducted during the last week of December 2022. Inspection was satisfactory.
- Conducted Recreation Leader II interviews (6) for current vacant positions within the Department.
- In conjunction with TNT Sports, conducted a successful first week of Winter Camp. We had a total of 20 campers during the first week.

Police Department

- The Village of Bal Harbour conducted a firework show on the jetty for New Year's Eve on December 31, 2022. The Surfside Police Department assisted the Bal Harbour Police Department with traffic control and pedestrian safety at the Hardpack and 96th Street Beach Access point from 10:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m.
