Dear Surfside Single-Family Property Owner:

A letter was included with your August 2011 water and sewer bill explaining the Utility Upgrade Project ("Project"). As part of the Project and at no cost to you, Surfside is connecting a new water meter to each of your houses (i.e., tie-in). Because the tie-in will be performed on your property, this requires your written permission on a form mailed previously with your August 2011 water and sewer bill. The permission form is also available at Town Hall and at the Project Website (http://www.utilityupgradeproject.com/). To date, the Town has received more than 300 authorizations, roughly 25 percent of the single family homes. In an effort to address specific questions submitted by residents, the Town offers the following responses:

### 1. What is the scope of work and will it include the irrigation meter?

The scope of work includes the relocation of potable water lines to the front of the single-family residential properties. As part of this work, you will receive a complete installation of both your water and irrigation (if applicable) meters at no cost.

### 2. Will the residents be required to obtain the services of a licensed plumber?

The services of a licensed plumber will be required only if the property owner refuses to sign the permission form, which allows the Town's contractor to complete the tie-in.

# 3. How long will the permission to enter your property last and who will be responsible for restoring the property to its condition at the time of the work?

The permission will be valid until the tie-in is completed. The contractor will be liable for any damage. Remember each home will have an individual plan for the new tie-in based on consultation with the property owner and the contractor. Existing conditions will be photographed so that restoration activities will be measureable to a recorded standard and any disagreements as to the level of restoration by the contractor will be settled by our Public Works Director.

### 4. Will the new water lines in your property require an easement?

### 5. Will the Town assure replacement costs for damage to walkways or driveways?

Each property will have an individual plan agreed to by the property owner. The existing conditions will be photographed and the contractor will be responsible for installation and restoration in a professional manner.

### 6. Will there be any cost to the residents for the water service installation?

This cost for the water service installation will be borne by the Town and has been funded with the recent water/sewer/storm drainage bond issue. There are no property taxes being used to fund the Project.

Please rest assured that you may chose to forego the Town's contractor in lieu of having the work done at your own expense by a private licensed plumber of your choice. We will notify you well in advance when the work must be done to allow time for you to obtain the service at your own expense.

While we understand this Project will be somewhat disruptive, we have done everything possible to complete the work as quickly and effectively as possible. We thank you in advance for your cooperation; this will help ensure the Project is completed in a timely manner.
