Construction activity is picking up steam around the site of the Town's new Community Center. The Town has received the required permits and completed ground testing.

The contractor will begin grading the site and installing foundation support piles. The Community Center building will require 122 supports and five for the Snack Bar/Lifeguard structure. Once the piles are completed, the underground utilities will be installed.

Turtle Season Continues Through October

Turtle season is May 1– October 31 and this year Surfside has three turtle nests. Two are located on 93rd street and one near 94th street. If you see an adult sea turtle or hatchling on the beach, **do not** report normal crawling or nesting (digging or laying eggs) to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWCC) unless the turtle has wandered off the beach (on a road or parking lot). Stay away from crawling or nesting sea turtles. Nesting is a critical stage in the sea turtle's life cycle. Leave them undisturbed. **REPORT** any stranded, injured or dead turtles to the FWCC. **NEVER** handle hatchling sea turtles. If you observe hatchlings wandering away from the ocean or on the beach, call: 1-888-404-FWCC or *FWC (mobile phone).




Souvenir 75th Anniversary Brochure Available

Town Commission Highlights

At the July 13, 2010 Town Commission Meeting, the Town Commission took the following actions:

Voted to approve the following resolutions:

- Appointing members of the Planning and Zoning Board
- Providing for a retainer agreement with Lewis Stroud & Deutsch to represent the Town in connection with *Bankes v. Surfside* matters
- Setting the preliminary operating millage for 2010-11
- Entering into an interlocal agreement with Miami-Dade County Transit Authority to purchase and install bus shelters using stimulus funds
- An agreement for the purchase, delivery and installation of parking pay stations
- An addendum to professional services agreement with AECOM for architectural services for Surfside Community Center

Voted to adopt these ordinances on second reading:

- Approve a 30-year nonexclusive franchise agreement with FP&L
- Provide for an alternate means to comply with off-street parking requirements in the downtown business district by payment of a mitigation fee into a parking trust fund

Voted to introduce ordinances on first reading:

- Provide for red light traffic control signals
- Amend Town Code to delete the requirement that municipal roads, facilities or properties must be named posthumously

Town Commission voted/concurred to:

- Direct Town Manager to prepare and issue a request for qualifications for architectural and engineering professional services
- Suspend Town Commission agenda meetings




